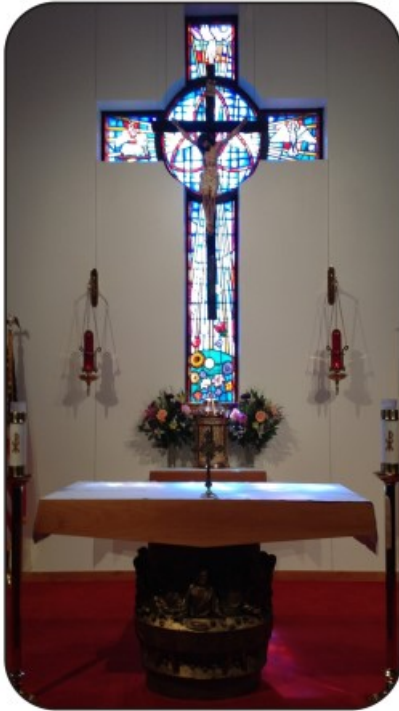

GOOD PRACTICES FOR LENT

- ❖ Attend **Mass on Ash Wednesday**. (It is not a Holy Day of Obligation.)
- ❖ Attend **Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent**. There is something special planned after Stations of the Cross on each Friday.
- ❖ Come to the **Parish Penitential Service on April 1, 6 pm**. Each of us is bound by Church Law to go to Confession at least once a year. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that “According to the Church’s command, “after having attained the age of discretion, each of the faithful is bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year.” (Council of Trent) Anyone who is aware of having committed a mortal sin must not receive Holy Communion, even if he experiences deep contrition, without having first received sacramental absolution, unless he has a grave reason for receiving Communion and there is no possibility of going to confession. Children must go to the sacrament of Penance before receiving Holy Communion for the first time. (CCC 1457)
- ❖ Know and follow the laws of fast and abstinence:
 - The law of fasting requires a Catholic from the 18th birthday to their 60th birthday to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal. The Church defines this as one meal a day, and 2 smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Such fasting is required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 - The law of abstinence requires a Catholic 14 years of age until death to abstain from eating meat on Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday. Abstinence from eating meat is required on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and, of course, Good Friday.
 - Those excused from fast or abstinence include those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, pregnant or nursing women according to need for meat or nourishment, manual laborers according to need, guests at a meal who cannot excuse themselves without giving great offense or causing enmity or other situations of moral or physical impossibility to observe the penitential discipline.

- ❖ Know and follow the Precepts of the Church:
 1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation and rest from servile labor.
 2. You shall confess your sins at least once a year.
 3. You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.
 4. You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
 5. You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.
