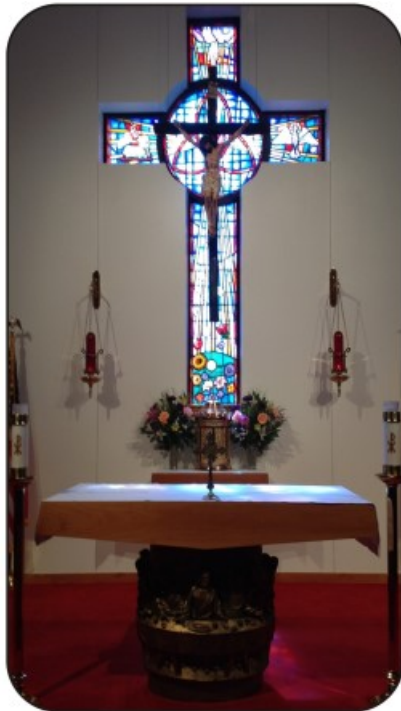

Temporary Liturgical Measures in Response to Concerns about Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

In order to prevent the spread of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in the territory of the Diocese of Tyler, Bishop Joseph Strickland has promulgated the following temporary regulations. These are effective March 10, 2020, and until further notice.

- The faithful should stay home if they are sick or are experiencing symptoms. If a person is ill, they are not bound by the obligation to attend Mass, including on Sunday. Out of charity to others, sick individuals should not attend liturgical celebrations or other parish events.
- Distribution from the common chalice during Communion is temporarily suspended.
- The exchange of a sign of peace is to be retained in all Masses (*Order of the Mass*, No. 128), temporarily, however, it is to be exchanged without physical contact.
- The holding of hands during Mass is not encouraged.
- The manner of receiving the host (in the hand or on the tongue) is the choice of each individual communicant. Both methods may risk the spread of disease, so it is important for ministers of Communion to exercise good hygiene. Nevertheless, if applicable, the faithful may consider receiving Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue.
- Ordinary and extraordinary ministers of Communion should practice good hygiene, washing hands with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer, before and after distributing Communion.

As a reminder, following the guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (<https://cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/>), the Diocese of Tyler recommends everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases, including:

- ✓ Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
 - ✓ Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
 - ✓ Stay home when you are sick.
 - ✓ Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
 - ✓ Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
 - ✓ Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
 - If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.

Medidas litúrgicas temporales en respuesta a las preocupaciones sobre el nuevo coronavirus (COVID-19)

Para tratar de prevenir el contagio de la enfermedad coronavirus (COVID-19) en el territorio de la Diócesis de Tyler, Mons. Joseph Strickland, obispo de Tyler, ha promulgado las siguientes normas temporales. Éstas son efectivas a partir del 10 de marzo de 2020, y hasta nuevo aviso.

- Los fieles deben quedarse en casa si están enfermos o experimentan síntomas. Si una persona está enferma, no está obligada a asistir a la misa, ni siquiera el domingo. Por caridad hacia los demás, los enfermos no deben asistir a las celebraciones litúrgicas u otros eventos parroquiales.
- La distribución del cáliz común durante la comunión se suspende temporalmente.
- El intercambio de un signo de paz debe mantenerse en todas las misas (*Ordinario de la Misa*, n. ° 128), aunque temporalmente debe intercambiarse sin contacto físico.
- Se alienta a los feligreses a no tomarse de las manos durante la misa.
- La forma de recibir la hostia (en la mano o en la lengua) es la elección de cada comulgante. Ambos métodos son un riesgo de propagación de enfermedades, por lo que es importante que los ministros de la Comunión ejerzan una buena higiene. Sin embargo, si es aplicable, los fieles pueden considerar recibir la comunión en la mano en lugar de en la lengua.
- Los ministros ordinarios y extraordinarios de la Comunión deben practicar una buena higiene, lavándose las manos con agua y jabón o con un desinfectante de manos a base de alcohol, antes y después de distribuir la Comunión.

Como recordatorio, siguiendo las directrices de los Centros de Control y Prevención de Enfermedades (<https://cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/>), la Diócesis de Tyler recomienda acciones preventivas diarias para ayudar a evitar la propagación de enfermedades respiratorias, incluyendo:

- ✓ Evitar el contacto cercano con personas que estén enfermas.
 - ✓ Evitar tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca.
 - ✓ Quedarse en casa cuando uno esté enfermo.
 - ✓ Cubrirse la boca al toser o estornudar con un pañuelo de papel, y luego tirar el pañuelo a la basura.
 - ✓ Limpiar y desinfectar los objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia usando un aerosol o una toallita de limpieza doméstica regular.
 - ✓ Lavarse las manos a menudo con agua y jabón durante al menos 20 segundos, especialmente después de ir al baño; antes de comer; y después de sonarse la nariz, toser o estornudar.
 - Si no se dispone de agua y jabón, usar un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol con al menos un 60% de alcohol. Siempre lavarse las manos con agua y jabón si las manos están visiblemente sucias.
