- **How to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy: (to be recited on ordinary rosary beads)**
Begin with: Our Father..., Hail Mary..., The Apostles' Creed.
Then, on the OUR FATHER BEADS, you say the following words: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
On the HAIL MARY BEADS you say the following words: For the sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
In conclusion, THREE TIMES you recite these words: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- **As you know, all parish and diocesan events are cancelled, including public Mass and all other liturgies. FATHER GOMEZ IS CELEBRATING DAILY MASS PRIVATELY, AND IS OFFERING THE MASS FOR THE SCHEDULED INTENTION.**
- **Father Gomez is available for CONFESSION on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 6-7 pm; on Saturday from 4-5 pm; and on Sunday morning from 9-10 am.**
- **During this pandemic, we encourage everyone to pray at home. Daily rosary is powerful, along with watching Mass on tv (Bishop Strickland is celebrating and live streaming Daily Holy Mass for you at 12 noon every day) and praying the Stations of the Cross.
