A Year of the Eucharist in the Diocese of Tyler

The real presence of Christ in the tabernacle Christ is present in the Holy Eucharist with his Body, his Blood, his Soul, and his Divinity. It is the same Jesus as the Jesus who was born in Bethlehem, who had to be carried in the arms of Joseph and Mary on the flight into Egypt. It is the same Jesus as the Jesus who grew up and worked hard in Nazareth, who died and rose again on the third day and who now, glorious, sits at the right hand of God the Father. It is Jesus himself! But it is logical that He cannot be in the same way, even though his presence is the same presence. *In the order of Christ*, writes St. Thomas, *his natural being is not the same as his sacramental being. But the reality of his presence is no less in the tabernacle than in Heaven: Christ is present whole and entire, bodily present too, in his physical "reality" although not in the manner in which bodies are present in a place. There is little more we can say about this admirable presence.* (from *In Conversation with God, Daily Meditations Volume 6: Special Feasts: January-June*, pages 278-279 by Francis Fernandez Carvajal)

- **Today we celebrate Pentecost, the birthday of the Church with the coming of the Holy Spirit. We also reflect on the gifts that the Spirit gives to each of us. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. (CCC 1831)**

- *This Friday, June 5, is First Friday of the month. Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will begin at 6 pm, followed by Holy Mass at 7 pm.*
