PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

- Usually, the elect and candidates enter into the Church at the Easter Vigil. This was not possible this year. Last weekend, on the Solemnity of Pentecost, all the elect in the Diocese of Tyler were baptized. This weekend, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, all candidates will enter into full communion in the Church. Our parish does not have any elect or candidates this year, but let us keep all our new Christian brothers and sisters in our prayers!
- Food Pantry is this Thursday, June 11, 9:00-11:30. It will be drive through only.
- *Next Sunday, June 14, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). There will be a **Eucharistic Procession** following the 9 am Holy Mass. **The Procession will begin about 10:10 am.** Everyone in the parish is invited to participate, no matter what Holy Mass you attend. **We will practice social distancing during the Procession.** You are also encouraged to wear a face mask if you so wish.*
- **Please remember that the Church is open daily from 8 am to 6 pm for private, individual prayer. Please continue to practice social distancing and other health protocol during this pandemic.**
- **FAITH FORMATION NEWS:** We are looking for someone who will assume the responsibilities of **Faith Formation Leader** for the 2020-2021 school year. We need someone who can start this summer to plan for the fall. Please see Father Gomez if you are interested in serving the parish in this way.
- Father's Day is June 21. Father's Day Spiritual Bouquet cards are available in the vestibule.
- **IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT:** *Father Gomez, our pastor, has been given a new assignment. He will continue serving as Vicar General/Moderator of the Curia/Promoter of Justice for the Diocese of Tyler, and he also will be a priest in residence at the Cathedral in Tyler, helping with pastoral duties in both English and Spanish there. His last day with us June 30th, and he begins his new assignment July 1. Our new pastor, Father Mark C. Kusmirek, had previous commitments before this assignment. He will arrive at St. Charles in August. Father Gary Rottman will be covering our parish until Father Mark arrives.*
