**A Year of the Eucharist in the Diocese of Tyler**

**Trust and respect for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.** The Eucharist never exhausts the ways in which Jesus can be present among us. He announced to us: *Lo, I am with you always until the close of the age.* He is with us in many ways. The Church reminds us that Christ is present in the needy, whether they belong to our family or whether they are strangers to us. He is present whenever we gather together in His name. In a special way He is present in the divine Word . . . All these are real ways of being present among us, but in the Holy Eucharist, God is present among us in a way **par excellence**, given that in this sacrament Christ is there in his very person, in a *true, real and substantial way.* This presence, {Saint} Pope Paul VI teaches, *is called 'real' not in an exclusive sense as though the other forms of presence were not 'real', but by reason of its excellence. It is the substantial presence, by which Christ is made present here among us, whole and entire, without doubt, both God and Man.* (from *In Conversation with God, Daily Meditations Volume 6: Special Feasts: January-June*, page 280 by Francis Fernandez Carvajal)
