

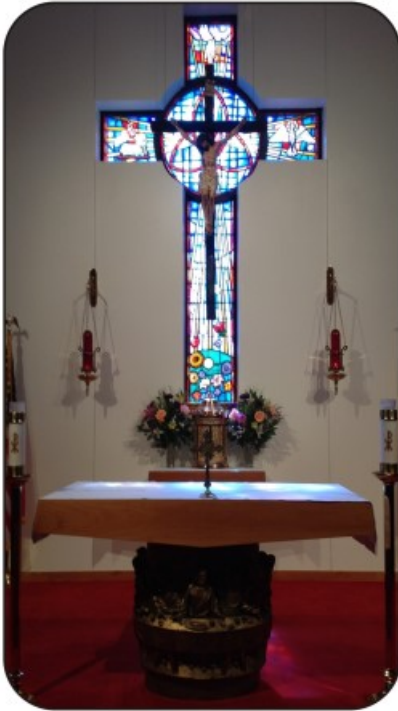

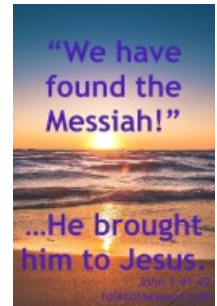

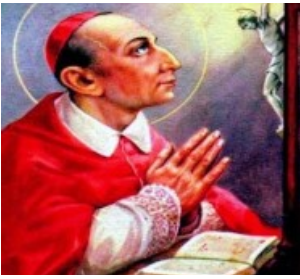

PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

- *Father Mark will be away from the parish January 12-21. During that time, there will not be daily Mass. Father Mike Snider will be the visiting priest for the weekend Masses while Father Mark is away.*



- The 2024 Bishop's Annual Appeal is coming! Watch for information coming to you in the mail. This will be the appeal's first request that you participate this year. Our parish goal is the same as last year, \$33,000. Please prayerfully consider contributing your fair share. Help the parish help support our diocese. - **What is Ordinary Time?** This Sunday when you go to Mass, the festive décor and white altar cloths of the Christmas Season will have replaced with the greens of Ordinary Time. So, just what is the Liturgical Season of Ordinary Time?

We turned to the USCCB for a short explanation:

“Christmas Time and Easter Time highlight the central mysteries of the Paschal Mystery namely, the incarnation, death on the cross, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus Christ, and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through the life of Christ.

This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ.

Ordinary Time is a time of growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.”

So, as you can see, Ordinary Time calls us to the extraordinary!

Sacrament of Penance: This great sacrament is for the healing of thoughts or actions of what we have done or failed to do. Please know confessions are heard on *Saturdays from 3:00 pm—3:50 pm and on Sundays from 8:00 am—8:50 am.* Examinations of Conscience are available to help guide your preparation.

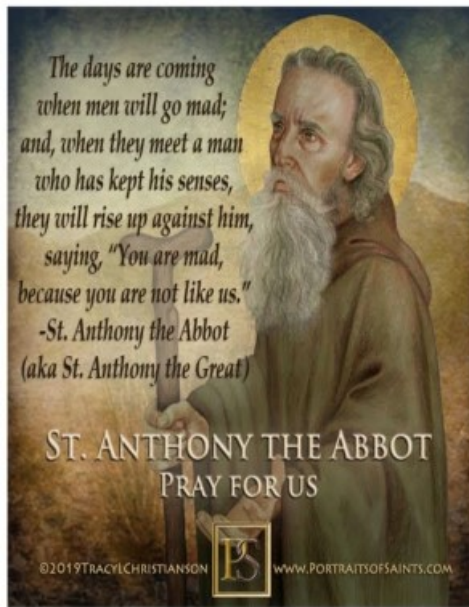
