- Little Black Books/Little Purple Books: The Little Black Book for adults in English or Spanish is available this weekend. The Little Book only takes about 6 minutes of your time each day and includes a little Catholic history and a short Bible passage with meditation. This book is a gift to you from our parish.
- The collection on Ash Wednesday is for Aid to the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. Please give generously.
- Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the start of the Lenten season. Mass and distribution of ashes are at 9am, 12pm, and 6:30pm.
- During Lent, the 12pm Friday Mass will be followed by praying the Stations of the Cross. The Stations of the Cross will also be prayed at 6:30pm each Friday. Gathering in prayer with other parishioners is a wonderful way to spend part of your Lenten Fridays. So many blessings, so much grace!

- Do you know where the ashes for ASH WEDNESDAY come from? Our Faith Formation youth do. On February 7, our students prepared and burned the palms that were blessed last year on Palm Sunday. Each child actively participated in the Palm Burning Ceremony. Our hope is to develop a biblical understanding and connection with Palm Sunday, Ash Wednesday, the 40 days of Lent, and Easter. The ceremony began by addressing the biblical symbol of ashes. Student lectors read Isaiah 58:5-10,Psalm 51, and ended with prayer and reflection.


