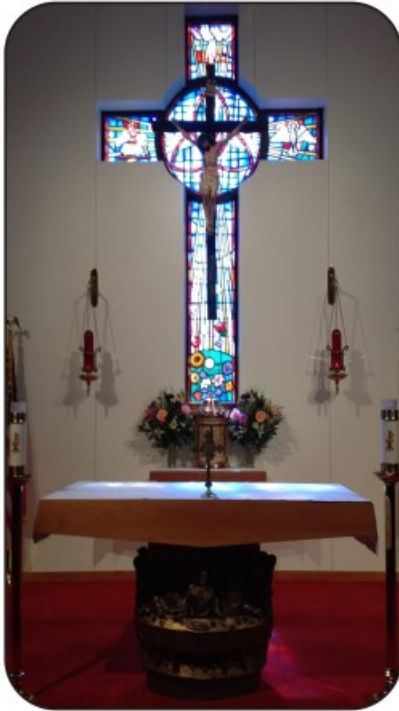

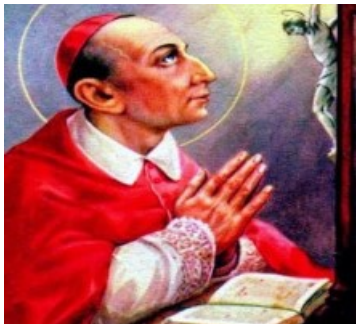

- **Our Lord said to St. Faustina:** "Encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you . . .Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior . . . Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy. . . Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will." *The Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet is prayed each day, starting on Good Friday and ending on the Saturday before Divine Mercy Sunday. We will pray the Novena together after each Mass. Copies are available in the church.*

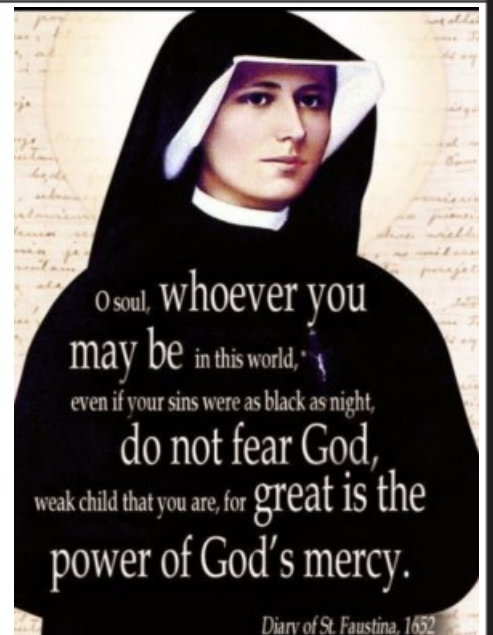
