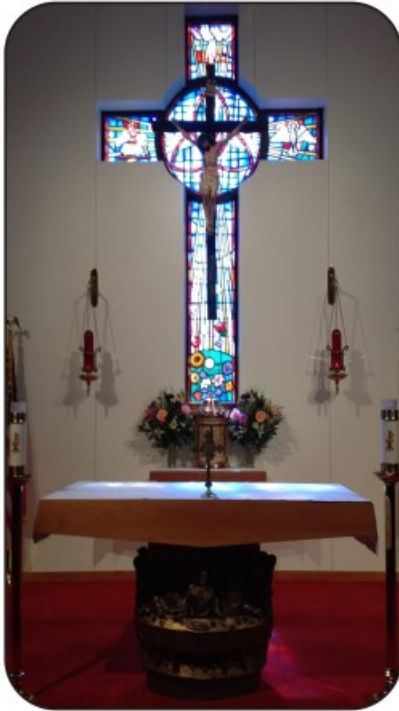

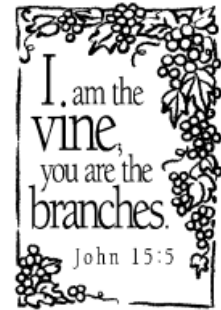

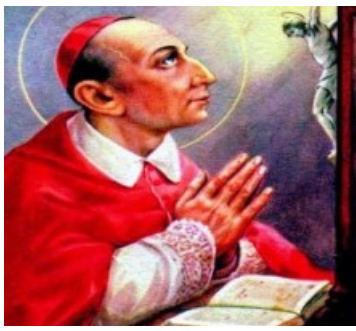

PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

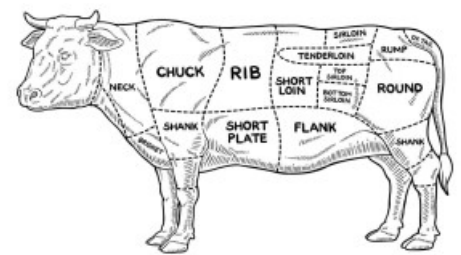
- The second collection this weekend is for Catholic Home Missions. Thank you for your support of this collection.

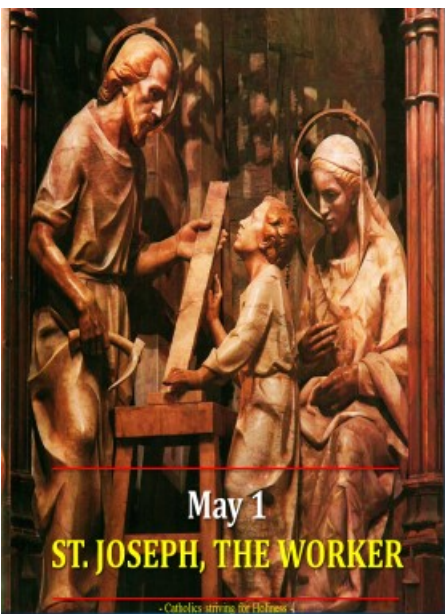
