

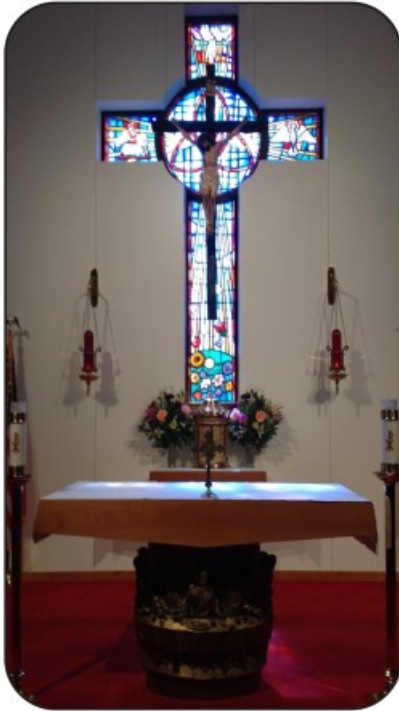

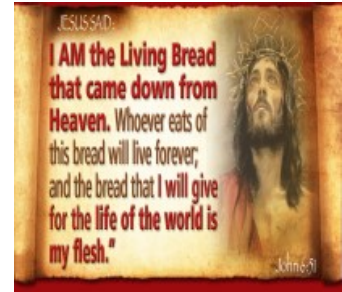

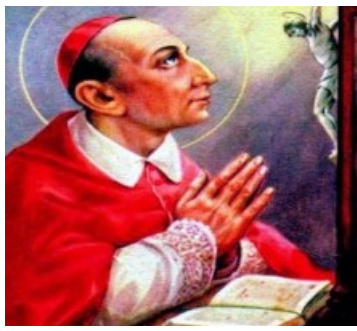

Holy Day of Obligation

• **This Thursday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION, so you are required by church law to attend Mass. Masses here at St. Charles Borromeo will be Wednesday at 6:30pm and on Thursday at 8am and 6:30pm.**

- **THE PARISH OFFICE WILL BE CLOSED on Tuesday morning, August 13 and on Thursday, August 15.**
- The Finance Committee will meet with Fr. Hank after the 630pm Mass on Thursday, August 15.
- *There will be a **special second collection** next weekend. It is to support the work of the Church in Ukraine and the Middle East. This collection will support 2 groups: The Sisters of Holy Family of Nazareth for a kindergarten in the Diocese of Zhytomyr; and for the Caritas-Spes Foundation for the Catholic Church in Ukraine. Please give generously. Thank you.*
- **CALLING ALL PARISHIONERS:** The food pantry board of directors would like to collect items once a quarter for items that we cannot purchase at the food bank. During the month of August we want to collect **CAKE OR BROWNIE MIXES** to be distributed to our Food Pantry clients in September. A big box is set up in the church foyer for collecting these items. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated.
- **Mosaic Counseling Sessions:** *Our parish is partnered with Mosaic Counseling Centers of East Texas to offer FREE counseling sessions to members of our parish. Counselors are available in person in Tyler, or via Ecounseling (by video). To be paired with a counselor simply call Mosaic at 903-593-9141.
