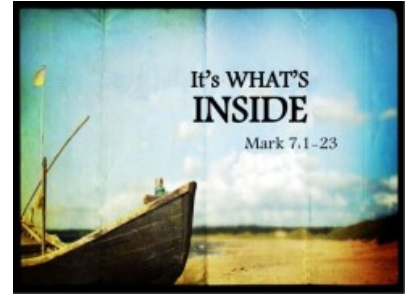

PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

- **First Friday** is this Friday, September 3. Mass will be at 6pm, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Adoration, and Benediction. There will not be a morning Mass.
- **Confessional:** "Confession is good for the soul." (St Augustine) Going to Confession is daunting. To help, we have increased the sound-proofing of the Confessional. Knowing what is said there is private. I was told people, at times, could be faintly heard in the Confessional. I needed to address that concern as soon as possible. Changes were made to alleviate that concern; we bought professional grade tiles to better ensure privacy. I thank those who brought that concern to me. - Fr. Mark
- **September; Month of Our Lady of Sorrows:** September 15th is the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. We remember our Blessed Mother as she stood beside the cross of Jesus. The Litany of Our Lady of Sorrows will be provided. I invite you to pray the Litany daily during September. Together we will pray the Litany on Fridays during September after Mass.
Did you know that every Friday of the year is known as a "little Good Friday." Abstaining from meat on Fridays continues to be a Friday practice. A little sacrifice goes a long way.
- **Catechists Sunday:** The weekend of **September 18 & 19**, we will have a blessing of Catechists and Faith Formation students. Sharing our Faith, well, that is what we all do.
- **Ethics and Integrity in Ministry:** The Diocese of Tyler expects all Church personnel – whether priest, deacon, religious, paid employee, or volunteer – to conduct their lives and ministry (whether in a parish, mission, Catholic school, or other Catholic institution or ministry) with ethics and integrity.

While the Second Vatican Council calls all baptized and confirmed Christians to holiness, the obligation upon Church personnel is increased because of their education and position. They should lead by an example that will inspire others to follow Jesus more closely in their life and they should always safeguard the well-being of others. Ethics and integrity in ministry require "doing what is right" rather than simply not breaking the rules. All Church personnel are to be committed to a life of ethics and integrity and formally commit themselves to the Code of Ethics and Integrity for the Conduct of Church Personnel in the Diocese of Tyler.

Catechists, and all those ministering in the name of the Church are required to have a background check and training.
