PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

- **Bishop Strickland respectfully asks that anyone attending any liturgical service wear a face mask. Thank you for protecting yourself and others!** 
- The Liturgy Committee will meet **Wednesday, January 13th** at 11am in the Parish Hall.
- The Food Pantry will open this **Thursday, January 14th**, from 9-1130am for anyone needing help with groceries. It is drive-through only and CDC protocols are used.
- Just a reminder that LOSC wants your aluminum cans! We are working to help the environment, as well as raise money to help others. Please bring your CLEAN ALUMINUM CANS, bagged. Place them in the bin behind the parish hall. We thank you for helping us help others with the funds we raise!
- **Next week we commemorate the Cemetery of the Innocents.** A field of white crosses—the Cemetery of the Innocents—will greet traffic on Hwy 1555, for one week, **January 17-23**. Each cross represents approximately 90 abortions per day worldwide. It is hard to have an exact number based on best information available at this time. These crosses are a vivid representation of approximately 80,000 abortions each day world wide. The intention is to bring greater awareness to respect human life in all stages and forms—especially as we commemorate the historic Supreme Court *Roe v. Wade* decision legalizing abortion. As you walk in to our church or drive by on Hwy 155, please make a sign of the cross, praying for these victims and their mothers.
- *Our parish pictorial directories are in the office! If you participated and have not picked up your copy, you may do so during regular office hours or next Saturday and Sunday after Mass. Participation means having a portrait taken in the parish hall last February or submitting a photo for inclusion in the directory.*
- **Please remember that the Church is open Monday through Saturday from 9 am to 3:30 pm for private, individual prayer.** Please continue to practice social distancing, wearing masks, and other health protocol during this pandemic.
- **Today we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.** “Through Baptism the Christian is sacramentally assimilated to Jesus, who in his own baptism anticipates his death and resurrection. The Christian must enter into this mystery of humble self-abasement and repentance, go down into the water with Jesus in order to rise with him, be reborn of water and the Spirit so as to become the Father’s beloved son in the Son and ‘walk in newness of life.’ Let us be buried with Christ by Baptism to rise with him; let us go down with him to be raised with him. Everything that happened to Christ lets us know that, after the bath of water, the Holy Spirit swoops down upon us from high heaven and that, adopted by the Father’s voice, we become sons of God.” CCC 537
