February is the Month of the Passion of our Lord.

### PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

• Bishop Strickland respectfully asks that anyone attending any liturgical service wear a face mask. Thank you for protecting yourself and others!



- Candlemas???? On February 2, Catholics mark the presentation of Christ in the temple. But not all Catholics are aware of the cultural origins of this feast. According to the Mosaic law, a mother such as Mary who had given birth to a male child was considered unclean for seven days; moreover, she was to remain "in the blood of her purification"—i.e., outside the temple—for thirty-three days more. If the woman had borne a daughter, the time that she was excluded from the sanctuary was doubled.
  - The blessing of candles: According to the Roman Missal, the celebrant, in stole and cope of purple, standing at the epist-le side of the altar, blessed the candles (which traditionally were of beeswax). Having sung or recited the five orations prescribed, he sprinkles and incenses the candles. Then he distributes them to the laity while saying the canticle of Simeon, *Nunc dimittis*. The antiphon "Lumen ad revelationem gentium et gloriam plebis tuae Israel" ("A light to the revelation of the Gentiles and the glory of thy people Israel") is repeated after every verse, according to the medieval custom of singing the antiphons.

The solemn procession represents the entry of Christ, who is the light of the world, into the Temple of Jerusalem. The procession is always kept on February 2, even when the office and Mass of the feast is transferred to February 3.

While today such processions are held inside the church, during the Middle Ages the clergy left the church and visited the cemetery surrounding it. Upon the return of the procession, a priest, carrying an image of the Holy Child, met it at the door and entered the church with the clergy, who recited the canticle of Zachary, "Benedictus Dominus Deus Israel" ("Blessed be the Lord God of Israel").

You are invited to bring candles from your home to be blessed and taken home with you. These can be used when the priest comes to bring communion or celebrate the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, or when there is a storm or problems in the home.

- This Friday is First Friday. Mass will begin at 6 pm, followed by Exposition and Adoration. There is no morning Mass.
- Our parish pictorial directories are in the office! If you participated and have not picked up your copy, please do so during regular office hours. Participation means having a portrait taken in the parish hall last February or submitting a photo for inclusion in the directory.
- Please remember that the Church is open Monday through Saturday from 9 am to 3:30 pm for private, individual prayer. Please continue to practice social distancing, wearing masks, and other health protocol during this pandemic.




