**Jesus comes in Person to heal and strengthen us.** In Holy Communion, even though we tell Jesus that we are not worthy, that our soul will never be sufficiently well disposed to receive him, He wants to come to us in Person — with his Body and his Soul — into our hearts, stained as they are with so many major and minor infidelities. Every day He repeats the words He spoke to his disciples as they began the Last Supper: *I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you.* How our hearts should fill with love and joy as we meditate on this great desire of Jesus to come into our soul! It is right to reflect seriously on the fact that **the miracle of transubstantiation was performed just for you, just for me. He came and dwelt there just for you ... No secondary agent, no intermediary, shall communicate to us the influence our souls need; He will come to us himself. **PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS**

- **Bishop Strickland respectfully asks that anyone attending any liturgical service wear a face mask. Thank you for protecting yourself and others!**
- **During the month of October, the Rosary will be prayed on Saturday beginning at 4:40 pm and on Sunday beginning at 8:40 am and 10:40 am. We will pray it in the Marian Garden, weather permitting.**
- **There will be a *Flu Clinic* here at St. Charles on **Sunday, October 11**, from 10am to noon. Medicare and Medicaid cards will be accepted for payment. All others will have to pay out of pocket, \$20 cash or check. Nurses from North East Texas Health will be administering the shots. Face masks and social distancing are required.**
- **Holy Hour and Remembrance Mass for Pregnancy and Infant Loss will be held on **Thursday, October 15th** at the Chapel of Saints Peter & Paul. This is for anyone who has experienced the loss of a child, whether by miscarriage, stillbirth, or early infant death. Holy Hour begins at 5 pm; Mass will begin at 6 pm. All are welcome! This event will also be live-streamed on the St. Philip Institute Facebook Page.**
- **Ethics and Integrity training for the Diocese of Tyler will be held here at St. Charles on **Saturday, October 17th**. CASE training will be led by Deacon Natera, beginning at 10 am. This training is for all parishioners who need to be recertified and all who need or want the basic certification.**
