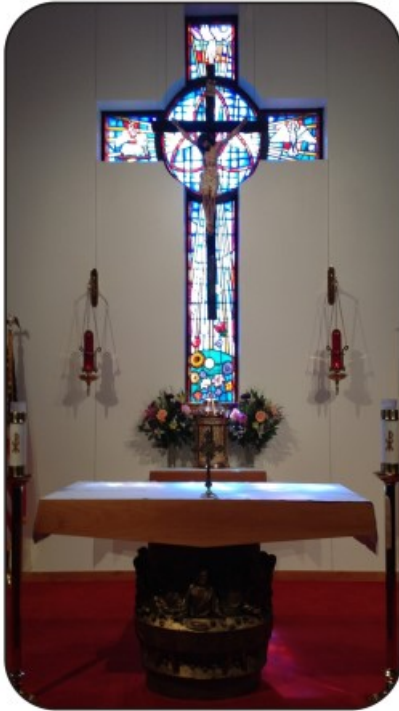

**A Year of the Eucharist in the Diocese of Tyler**

**Sustenance for the journey. Ardently desiring to receive Holy Communion. Avoiding all sense of routine.** Jesus Christ, who gives himself to us in the Holy Eucharist, is utterly indispensable as nourishment for us. Without him we very soon fall into an extreme state of weakness. St. Thomas writes: *“Material food first changes into the one who eats it, and then, as a consequence, restores to him his lost strength and increases his vitality. **Spiritual food, on the other hand, changes the person who eats it into itself. Thus the effect proper to this sacrament is the conversion of a man into Christ, so that he may no longer live, but Christ lives in him;** consequently, it has the double effect of restoring the spiritual strength he had lost by his sins and defects, and of increasing the strength of his virtues.”* (from *In Conversation with God, Daily Meditations Volume Six: Special Feasts: January-June*, pages 300-301 by Francis Fernandez Carvajal)

## October, Month of the Holy Rosary

October recalls the intercession of the Blessed Mother during a critical point of European history. In 1571 the Ottoman Muslims were intent on conquering Europe by both land and sea. A great sea invasion had been planned for many years by the Ottomans.

Europe and the Church were in disarray with small kingdoms supporting the Pope and the Protestant reformation as well.

The sea battle occurred on October 7, 1571 off the coast of Greece. The Catholic forces were outnumbered. Pope St. Pius V asked all Europe to pray the rosary asking Mary's intercession.

At a critical time in the sea battle additional ships under the command of Admiral Andrea Doria joined the battle. The Catholic fleet won and the course of history was changed.

Please pray the rosary daily. It is our best spiritual defense. Please, teach your children and grandchildren.



## Saints Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael's Story

Angels—messengers from God—appear frequently in Scripture, but only Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are named.

Michael appears in Daniel's vision as "the great prince" who defends Israel against its enemies; in the *Book of Revelation*, he leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil. Devotion to Michael is the oldest angelic devotion, rising in the East in the fourth century. The Church in the West began to observe a feast honoring Michael and the angels in the fifth century.

Gabriel also makes an appearance in Daniel's visions, announcing Michael's role in God's plan. His best-known appearance is an encounter with a young Jewish girl named Mary, who consents to bear the Messiah.

Raphael's activity is confined to the Old Testament story of Tobit. There he appears to guide Tobit's son Tobiah through a series of fantastic adventures which lead to a threefold happy ending: Tobiah's marriage to Sarah, the healing of Tobit's blindness, and the restoration of the family fortune.

The memorials of Gabriel and Raphael were added to the Roman calendar in 1921. The 1970 revision of the calendar joined their individual feasts to Michael's.
