

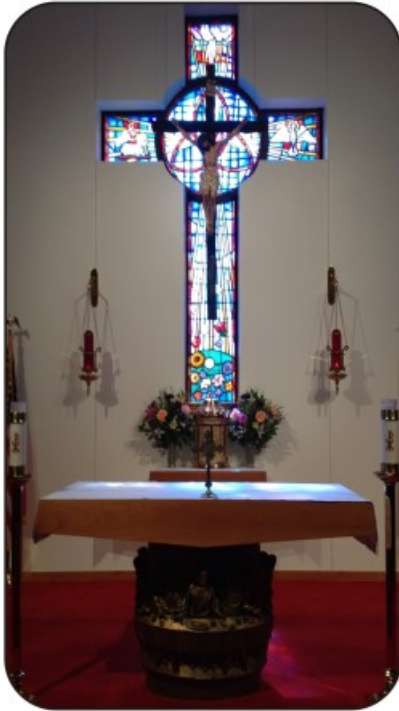

**PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS**

- **Mardi Gras Celebration next Sunday after the 9am Mass!** Everyone is invited to come join us in a last little celebration before Ash Wednesday and the start of the Season of Lent. 
- **Catholic East Texas:** the newest edition is now available. Copies available at the church entrance and parish office.
- **The Sacrament of Baptism: Gateway to New Life;** The sacrament of Baptism is the beginning of life — supernatural life.  
Because of original sin, we come into the world with a soul which is supernaturally dead. We come into the world with only the natural endowments of human nature. The supernatural life which is the result of God’s personal and intimate indwelling, is absent from the soul.  
Original sin is not, in the strict sense, a “blot” upon the soul. Indeed, original sin is not a “something” at all. It is the **absence** of something that should be there. It is darkness where there ought to be light.  
Jesus instituted the sacrament of **Baptism** to apply to each individual soul the atonement which He made on the Cross for original sin.  
Jesus will not force His gift upon us, the gift of supernatural life for which He paid. He holds the gift out to us hopefully, but each of us must freely accept it.  
We make that acceptance by receiving the sacrament of Baptism.  
When the sacrament of Baptism is administered, the spiritual vacuum which we call original sin disappears as God becomes present in the soul ,and the soul is caught up into that sharing of God’s own life which we call **sanctifying grace**.
- *We continue our guidance from our Bishops on the Bible:*  
**#5 of 10 Know what the Bible is—and what it isn’t.** The Bible is the story of God’s relationship with the people He has called to Himself. It is not intended to be read as history text, a science book, or a political manifesto. In the Bible, God teaches us the truths that we need for the sake of our salvation.
- There will be NO daily Mass this week. Father Mark will be away from the parish. He and other priests of the Diocese of Tyler will be on retreat with Bishop Strickland. Please remember them in your prayers.

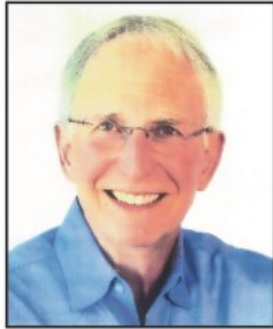

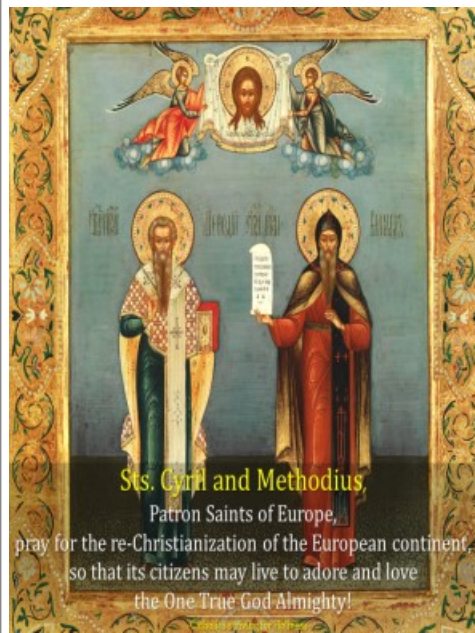
