

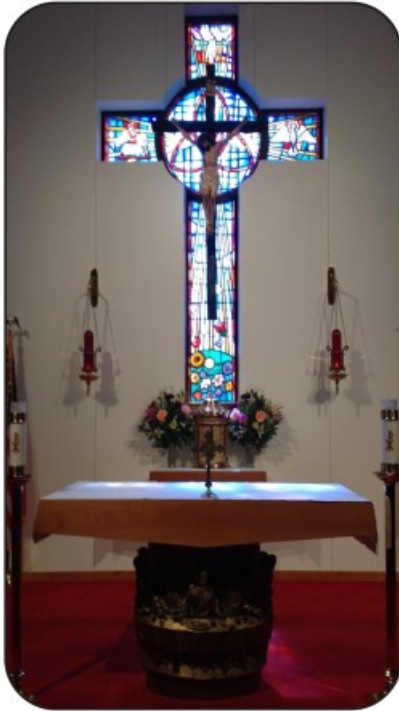

- **ASH WEDNESDAY:** Mass and Imposition of Ashes will take place at 8am, 12pm, and 6:30pm.



- **Volunteers are needed** to supply meatless soup at each of our Friday lunches during Lent. The dates are Friday, February 24, March 3, March 10, and March 17. The meal will be enjoyed after the 12pm Mass and Stations of the Cross. Please sign up in the vestibule or let Therese know which Friday you can help. There are usually 2-3 different soups served at each meal. The folks who bring the soup usually help clean up after the meal.

- **On Fridays during Lent, we will serve meatless soups for lunch after 12pm Mass and Stations of the Cross. Please join us each Friday for Mass, Stations of the Cross, and lunch!**
- **Stations of the Cross will be prayed on Fridays after 12pm Mass and at 6:30pm.**
- **We continue our guidance from our Bishops on the Bible:**
#6 of 10 The sum is greater than the parts. Read the Bible in context. What happens before and after — even in other books — helps us to understand the true meaning of the text.
- There will be a Special Collection on Ash Wednesday for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. 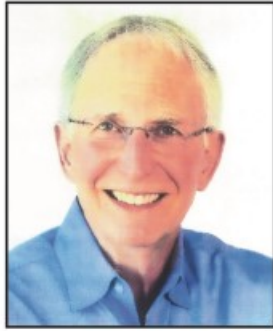
