

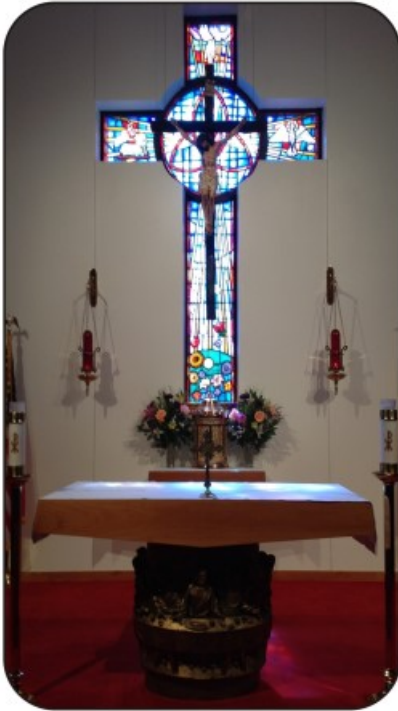

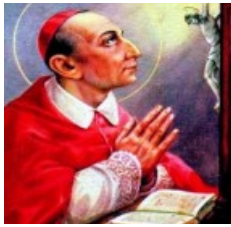

*We begin our guidance from the Bishops on the Bible:*  
**#1 Bible reading is for Catholics.** The Church encourages Catholics to make reading the Bible part of their daily prayer lives. Reading these inspired words, people grow deeper in their relationship with God and come to understand their place in the community God has called them to in himself.
- Next week we will take up the **Collection for the Church in Latin America**. Your support for the collection provides lay leadership training, catechesis, priestly and religious formation, and other programs to share our Catholic faith with those who long to hear the Good News of Christ. - **February 11: Rosary Rally— Here!** Catholics from across the Diocese will be here on Saturday, February 11 at 1:00pm for a Rosary Rally honoring Our Lady of Fatima. Join us for this day of prayer. Schedule: begin at 1:00pm with Rosary and prayers, 3:00pm Confessions and 4:00pm Mass. Prayers continue until Mass begins. We entrust our nation to the Blessed Mother’s care. We celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick during mass.
- **Year of Baptism & St. John the Baptist:** Last year Bishop Strickland asked us to focus on the theme of the Eucharist. This year our theme is the sacrament of Baptism and St. John the Baptist.
- **Heartfelt thanks:** During our medical emergency at last Sunday’s 9:00am mass, our response was effective and appropriate. Trained parishioners saw the emergency and administered appropriate help. Each of us helped in our best way: we prayed. I thank you all for your extraordinary response. -Fr.Mark

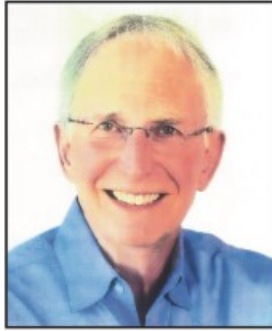
