

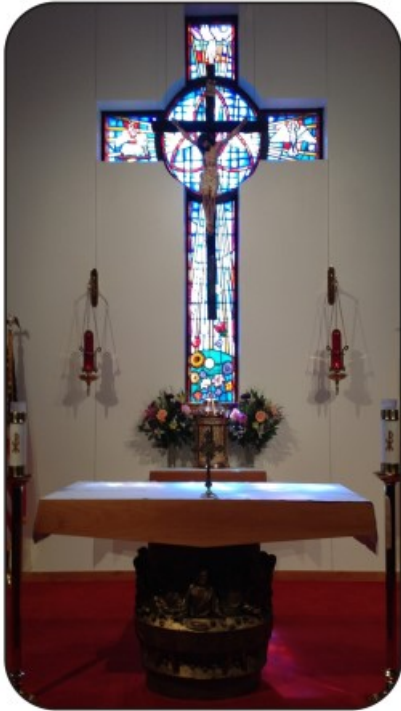

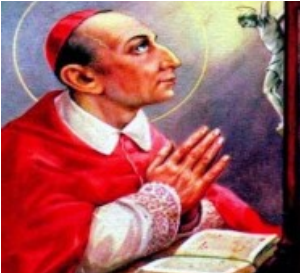

PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

- The second collection this weekend is for the Church in Africa. Please be as generous as you can.
- **Bible Study, Gospel of Matthew:** Meets Thursday, from 6-7pm. Everyone is invited to come!
- **Help LOSC help our Students!** School starts August 2 and LOSC will be providing our students with \$25 WALMART gift cards to purchase back to school supplies. If you are interested in helping, you can either donate money or a \$25 gift card. There will be a basket in the church in which to put your donations. **Please turn them in by July 23.**
- **Food Pantry Update:** We served 132 families for a total of 396 family members. We totally ran out of food except for a few bags of walnuts and noodles. Thanks to all the volunteers for their dedication to this effort for feeding the hungry in our surrounding communities. It was hot and very windy.
- Our lives are complex and at times we need help. **Mosaic** is a professional, licensed counseling service of more than 10 years. You can receive 8 free counseling sessions to help you. Issues from child rearing, marital relationships, bereavement, depression, anxiety and more can be discussed. You may meet with the counselor at their offices in Tyler, by way of video conference or here at our Education Building. Meetings are anonymous, no one here will know who is receiving counseling.
- **Holy Water fonts:** Holy Water is available at the church entrance to refresh your fonts at home. Blessings with Holy Water are a great reminder of our Baptism and desire to be free from sin. It is also a protection against temptations.
- Saints **Joachim** (sometimes spelled “Joaquin,” pronounced “wal-keem”) and **Anne** are the parents of the **Virgin Mary**. There are no mentions of them in the Bible or Gospels, what we know comes from Catholic legend and the Gospel of James, which is an unsanctioned, apocryphal writing from the second century AD. We do know from scholarship that the Gospel of James was not written by James, the Brother of Jesus, despite its claim to be so authored.

Even the early Church fathers expressed skepticism about the Gospel of James in their writings. There are about 150 copies of the ancient manuscript which often have different titles, but tell the same story, that Mary was promised to Joachim and Anne by an angel, was consecrated to God, and she remained a virgin all her life.

Naturally, there is plenty of room for scholarly debate about these saints. We have no true primary sources that prove they even existed, but certainly we can agree that Mary had parents. Likewise, we can agree to that.

Mary had good faithful parents who raised her with a love and devotion to God like none except Jesus Christ Himself.

Joachim and Anne serve as role models for parents and both deserve to be honored and emulated for their devotion to God and Our Lady Mary, the Mother of God.

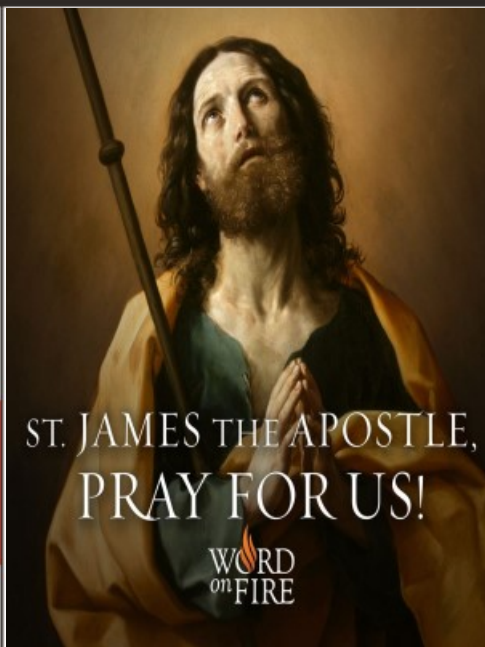
