

- The Fourth of July is coming soon. Our Nation is always in need of our prayers. **Mass on Tuesday, July 4th is at 9:00 am here at St. Charles.** It's not only about barbecues and fireworks. It's also about Faith and God's Grace. Please invite others. Also, copies of the Declaration of Independence will be provided.
- The Office will be closed Tuesday, July 4 in observance of Independence Day.
- July 7 is First Friday. 12pm Mass will be followed by Exposition and Benediction.
- <u>Bible Study, Gospel of Matthew:</u> The remainder of this liturgical year the Gospel is from Matthew. Beginning Thursday, July 18, from 7 pm—8 pm we will learn more about what St. Matthew says and hear and reflect on the Gospel from the upcoming Sunday. Other Items of Interest:

- If it's raining before or after our masses, six **extra-large umbrellas** are available to escort you to and/or from your cars.
