- **The Fourth of July is coming soon.** Our Nation is always in need of our prayers. **Mass on Tuesday, July 4th is at 9:00 am here at St. Charles.** It's not only about barbecues and fireworks. It's also about Faith and God's Grace. Please invite others. Also, copies of the Declaration of Independence will be provided.
- **The Office will be closed Tuesday, July 4 in observance of Independence Day.**
- **July 7 is First Friday. 12pm Mass will be followed by Exposition and Benediction.**
- **Bible Study, Gospel of Matthew:** The remainder of this liturgical year the Gospel is from Matthew. Beginning Thursday, July 18, from 7 pm—8 pm we will learn more about what St. Matthew says and hear and reflect on the Gospel from the upcoming Sunday. Should there much interest additional days and times might be added.

Other Items of Interest:

- If it's raining before or after our masses, six **extra-large umbrellas** are available to escort you to and/or from your cars.
