

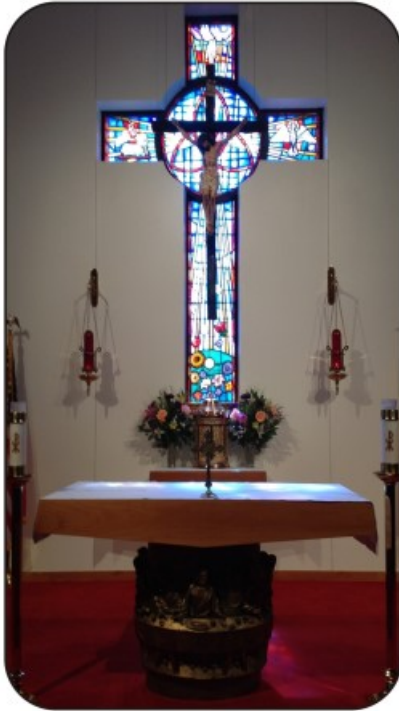

PARISH NEWS

- **This Friday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.** *Jesus knew and loved us each during his life, his agony, and his Passion and gave himself up for each one of us: “The Son of God...loved me and gave himself for me.” (Galatians 2:20) He has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, (Cf. John 19:34) “is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that...love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings” without exception. (Pius XII, encyclical, Haurietis aquas {1956}) (CCC 478)*
- **This Friday, June 28th, is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. A special Holy Mass for all parishioners will begin at 6 pm, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. There will not be a morning Mass.**

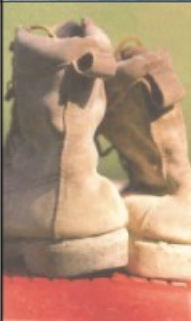
