- The Men’s Club will hold their June monthly meeting on **Monday, June 3rd**, beginning at 6 pm in the Parish Hall. They will not meet in July or August.
- The Ladies of St. Charles will hold their final meeting before the Summer break on **Tuesday, June 4th**, beginning at 6 pm in the Parish Hall.
- **First Friday is this week, June 7th.** Mass begins at 6 pm, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. There is no morning Mass.
- Father’s Day is Sunday, June 16th. Father’s Day Cards and Remembrance envelopes are available in the foyer. **Deadline to return Father’s Day envelopes is Tuesday, June 11th.**
- *Next weekend we will celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. The Church was made manifest to the world on the day of Pentecost by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. In this new era of the Church, Christ now lives and acts in and with His Church, in a new way appropriate to this new era. He acts through the sacraments in what the common Tradition of the East and the West calls “the sacramental economy”, the dispensation of the fruits of Christ’s Paschal mystery in the celebration of the Church’s sacramental liturgy. (CCC1076) **The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit** are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. (CCC1831) **The fruits of the Spirit**, as listed by the tradition of the Church, are charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. (CCC1832)*
- Father Gomez will be away from the parish June 7-11 on diocesan business. He will be in Mexico City to help with the ordination to the priesthood of Deacon Juan Pedro Gonzalez. The ordination will take place in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe on Saturday, June 8th. Please pray for this soon-to-be newest priest for the Diocese of Tyler! 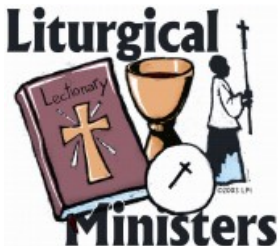

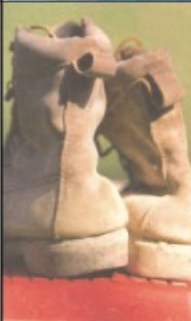
