- *Our monthly Pot Luck will be held today after the 9 am Mass. Please join the food, fun, and fellowship!*
- **This Tuesday, March 19th**, is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will have a special Holy Mass on that day beginning at 6 pm. Our presider will be Bishop Joseph Strickland, and Father Gomez will concelebrate. The Mass will honor St. Joseph and our bishop. During this Mass, Bishop Strickland will install Father Gomez as pastor of our parish. A reception in the parish hall will follow. **There will not be a morning Mass on Tuesday.**
- Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday beginning at 6 pm. Father Gomez will also present a special meditation afterwards.
- There will NOT be a Sunday Social on Sunday, March 24th. However, the Men’s Club will have their monthly Pancake Breakfast on Sunday, March 31st.
- A Health Hint from Our Nurse: At least 228 measles cases have been reported in the U.S. this year, CDC says. Texas has seen at least 11 cases this year as of March 8th. Measles is a highly contagious, vaccine-preventable respiratory illness characterized by a rash of flat, red spots. Symptoms may include fever, cough, runny nose, water eyes, and sore throat. It is spread by contact with an infected person through coughing and sneezing. Measles is so contagious that if someone has it, 90% of the people around that person who are not immune will become infected. Some people may suffer from severe complications, such as pneumonia and encephalitis (swelling of the brain). Measles may cause pregnant women to give birth prematurely, or to have a low-birth-weight baby. If you are not sure whether you were vaccinated as a child, talk with your doctor. If you were born before 1957, you are presumed to have immunity against measles. (Information on measles obtained from Centers for Disease Control) —Sue Owens, R.N., Parish Nurse

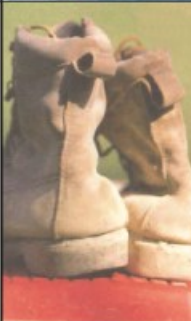
