

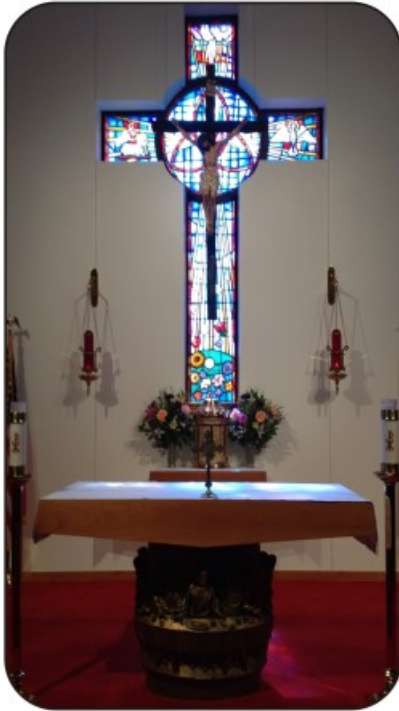

PARISH AND DIOCESAN NEWS

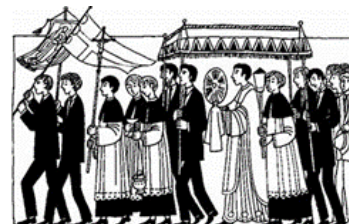
Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Why are we here? All of us are called to be saints! We are reborn into God's Family by our Baptism and Confirmation and are nourished by the Holy Eucharist. As God's children moved by the Spirit—yes, possessed by the Holy Spirit—we cry out, "Abba, Father," when we pray as Jesus taught us. We have the task of continuing the messianic work of our brother, of leading all people to the Father, through Jesus, in the powerful Holy Spirit.

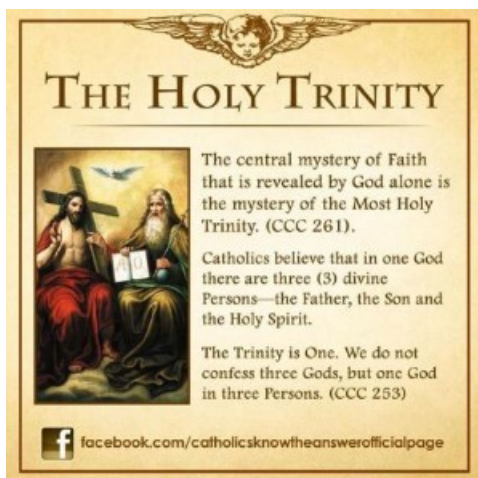

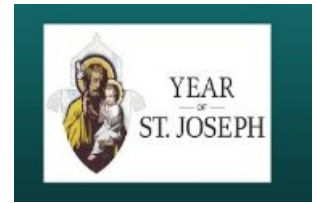


